### **Tier 1 - Open Attendance**

- Admission: \$5.00/adult; \$3.00/student.
- Limited concessions available.
- Protective face coverings are strongly encouraged.

#### **Visiting Fans**

- Use Entrance A (west side).
- Sit on the west bleachers - every other row.
- Elementary children need to sit with their families.
- Use the restrooms at Entrance A.

#### **Viking Fans**

- Use Entrance C (south side).
- Sit on the east bleachers - every other row.
- Elementary children need to sit with their families.
- Use the restrooms at Entrance C.
