JVCS Executive Board met on Monday, October 19, 2020.

Devotions were led by Jeremy Blom. Reports from the treasurer, secretary, and administration were given and approved.

Board members discussed ongoing concerns with flooring in commons, vocal music room, and the community entrance.

Plans were made for the upcoming Vanderbloemen Consultation visit.

Discussion was held on the length of student COVID-19 quarantine time for asymptomatic close contacts. The board approved amending the current quarantine time for asymptomatic close contacts to seven days. Students would be able to return to school on the eighth day if they were still symptom-free. Administration would have heightened awareness and monitoring of these individuals.

The board approved upgrading our internet quality through Midco.

The board approved adding more WiFi access points to the school building.

A Dept. of Education administrative waiver for a teacher's Plan of Intent was approved.

The next board meeting is planned for Monday, November 9, at 6:30.
